The Exchange has determined to wind down trading in following equity options:

Firms which conduct public customer business in these options should note that Exchange Rule 916.06 requires such firms to advise customers (1) of the commencement of withdrawal procedures set forth above prior to effecting any further transactions in such options, and (2) that the Exchange may prohibit certain types of transactions in such options. At this time, the Exchange is not imposing any restrictions concerning the trading of such options.
